SUBJECT: OSAA Classification and Districting Committee – September 26 Meeting Update

The Classification and Districting Committee for the 2010-2014 four-year time block held its initial meeting at the OSAA office in Wilsonville on September 26, 2008. The constitutionally mandated purpose of this Committee is to make recommendations to the OSAA Executive Board for adoption in October 2009, regarding classification and district assignments for the next four-year time block.

The Classification and Districting Committee is chaired by John Harrington, President, Central Catholic High School. Following a review of the charge to the Committee by the Executive Board, the Committee discussed general Committee procedures and set a calendar of future meetings.

The OSAA staff will provide a Committee update, similar to this one, to all superintendents, principals, and athletic directors following each meeting. The Committee welcomes all written suggestions regarding any classification and districting related subjects. Any communication from school representatives regarding Committee issues should be sent to the OSAA rather than to individual Committee members. For the next meeting, the Committee is particularly interested in hearing from school districts that anticipate adding a new high school prior to or during the next four-year time block. The Committee would also like to hear from any schools which “played up” during the current time block or intend to “play up” during the upcoming time block confirming future plans.

The next meeting of the Classification and Districting Committee will take place on Monday, October 20, 2008, at 1 p.m. at the Doubletree-Lloyd Center, Portland, (following the morning Delegate Assembly meeting). The Committee meeting will include an opportunity for public testimony early on the agenda.
