SUBJECT: Summary of Executive Board Action at the May 4, 2009, Meeting

At the meeting on May 4, 2009, at the OSAA Office, the OSAA Executive Board took the following actions:

- Approved the minutes of the February 2, March 13, and April 6, 2009, Board Meetings.
- Acknowledged the service of outgoing Board members Dave Courtney and Randy Wharton.
- Adopted a "State Championships – Yearly Executive Board Review" Board Policy effective in Fall, 2009. The policy stipulates that the Board will review proposals to alter state championships in February during the years that the State Championship Committee does not meet.
- Voted to delete Board Policy #4 "Alternative Schools" effective Fall, 2009, because of recent action by the Delegate Assembly that placed alternative school student eligibility under Rule 8.5 "School Representation" starting in Fall, 2009.
- Voted to delete Board Policy #69 "State Championship – Adding a Championship" effective Fall, 2009, because of recent action by the Delegate Assembly that placed the authority for making Championship addition decisions with the Delegate Assembly under Rule 6 starting in Fall, 2009.
- Adopted additional Questions and Answers for the 2009-2010 OSAA Handbook to clarify recently amended Rule 8.1 "Academic Eligibility". (ATTACHED)
- Reviewed OSAA Board Policy #38 "Financing Options", and directed staff to distribute copies of the Board Policy to member schools as a reminder to those school districts which may be contemplating non-traditional funding options for high school athletics and activities.
- Reviewed the OSAA position statement recently sent to schools regarding H1N1 Virus ("Swine Flu").
- Approved the proposed Association Budget presented by the OSAA Budget Committee.
- Adopted the Officials Fee Review Committee Recommendations regarding fourth officials in soccer, line judges in volleyball, and cancelled contest fees in baseball/softball for OSAA playoff contests starting in 2009-2010 school year. Forwarded an Officials Fee Review Committee proposal regarding league game cancelled contest fees in baseball/softball for consideration at the October Delegate Assembly Meeting.
- Adopted to freeze the mileage reimbursement rates for the 2009-2010 school year at:
 - 50.5 cents per mile for Officials
 - 43.5 cents per mile for the Executive Board
 - 35 cents per mile for all others
- Tabled Special District Assignments for Spring 2010 until the Board Summer Workshop.
- Adopted the Association Calendar for 2009-2010 and 2010-11. (ATTACHED)
- Appointed James Hiu, Principal, Sam Barlow High School, to serve a three-year term as the 6A/5A/4A At-Large Representative to the Executive Board.
- Approved an Application for Full Membership from Corbett Charter School starting in Fall, 2009.

- Tabled a Cooperative Sponsorship Request from Weston-McEwen High School and Griswold High School in Football until further information can be gathered from potentially affected schools.
- Sponsored a proposal from the Classification and Districting Committee to the Delegate Assembly to allow schools to Petition to Play Down for the duration of a Four-Year Time Block. A "Petition to Play Down Form" will be developed by staff and distributed to members schools. Any action by the Board in response to a "Petition to Play Down Form" would be conditional upon adoption of the proposed change by the Delegate Assembly.
- Adopted a Q&A interpretation of the Participation Limitations which will allow a 1A sub-varsity team to participate against a 1A varsity team without counting the contest as varsity competition for the sub-varsity school if certain conditions are met. (ATTACHED)
- Received an Oregon Athletic Directors Association (OADA) Report from Craig Rothenberger and Bill Bowers.
- Received an Oregon Athletic Coaches Association (OACA) Report from Marv Heater.
- Received an Oregon Athletic Officials Association (OAOA) Report from Jack Folliard.
- Reviewed and assigned penalties where appropriate for rule violations self-reported by member schools. (ATTACHED)

QUESTION: Should the Executive Board adopt Q&A's clarifying the “Minimum Satisfactory Progress Requirements” that have been added to Rule 8.1 – “Attendance – Semester – Grades” for the 2009-2010 school year?

RATIONALE: The new Q&A's are intended to clarify a number of potential questions regarding the new requirements.

Rule 8 Individual Eligibility

8.1.2 Satisfactory Progress Toward Graduation. In addition to the specific credit requirement identified in Rule 8.1.1., to be scholastically eligible, a student must also be making satisfactory progress towards the school's graduation requirements by earning a minimum of the quantity of credits indicated on the chart below for the specified year.

Minimum Satisfactory Progress Requirements

PROPOSED NEW Q&A's:

1. **Q. If a student is ineligible at the beginning of the school year due to having recorded too few credits to meet the “Minimum Satisfactory Progress Requirements”, does the period of ineligibility cover the entire school year?**
A. Yes. The only circumstance under which a student could regain eligibility during the school year would be if the Executive Director granted eligibility in response to the submission of an “Eligibility Request Form” by the school.

2. **Q. If the quantity of credits recorded at the end of the first transcribed grading period added to the credits recorded prior to the start of the school year exceeds the “Minimum Satisfactory Progress Requirements” necessary prior to that grade level, does the student become eligible for participation during the second semester?**
A. No.

3. **Q. If a student is granted a hardship waiver to allow participation despite having recorded too few credits to meet the “Minimum Satisfactory Progress Requirements”, what period of time does the waiver cover?**
A. Assuming that there are no other eligibility issues regarding the student, the student is eligible for the full school year during which the appeal was granted.

Proposal to Add Q&A – “Participation Limitations”

(Action Item)

QUESTION: *Should the Executive Board add a Q&A to the Participation Limitations section of the Handbook that gives 1A schools additional flexibility in scheduling contests at their level.*

RATIONALE: Currently, some 1A schools field Varsity teams that are only competitive at the sub-varsity levels due to a variety of reasons. The change would give the flexibility to accommodate these teams in a league schedule without impacting participation limits at the Varsity level.

RULE CHANGE SPONSORED BY: OSAA Staff (supported by the 1A Classification)

POSSIBLE RULE CHANGES:

KEY: Add Delete

3. Q. May a ~~6A-5A-4A-3A-2A~~ JV team participate against a varsity team from the same classification?

A. Yes, but the contest would count as a varsity contest for both schools. Any contest between two teams in the same classification shall be considered to have taken place at the level, i.e. JV or varsity, of the higher-level team unless written permission is received from the Executive Director prior to the contest. The Executive Director will consider granting an exception only in emergency situations and with league approval.

4. Q. ***May a 1A sub-varsity team participate against a varsity team from the same classification and not have the contest count towards the varsity participation limitation for that school?***

A. ***Yes, but the following conditions are in effect:***

- 1. Mutual agreement between schools involved and notifications to league completed by designated first contest date for that sport.***
- 2. The varsity team is required to forfeit the contest to the other school.***
- 3. The school receiving the forfeit is allowed to schedule an additional contest to replace the forfeited contest but must remain within defined individual and team participation limitation for the sport.***

4. 5. Q. How is a contest between a JV team and another sub-varsity (JV, JV2, Sophomore, Frosh, etc.) team counted?

A. Any contest between sub-varsity teams counts as a contest at the level (JV, JV2, Sophomore, Frosh, etc.) of each of the respective teams regardless of the classification. For example, in a contest between a JV team and a JV2 team of the same classification, the JV team would count the contest as a JV contest, and the JV2 team would count the contest as a JV2 contest. (Unlike in games involving a varsity team playing a sub-varsity opponent of the same classification or higher where both teams would be required to count the contest as a varsity contest, this interpretation would apply regardless of the classifications of the two sub-varsity teams that are playing.)
