

Soccer Field Diagram

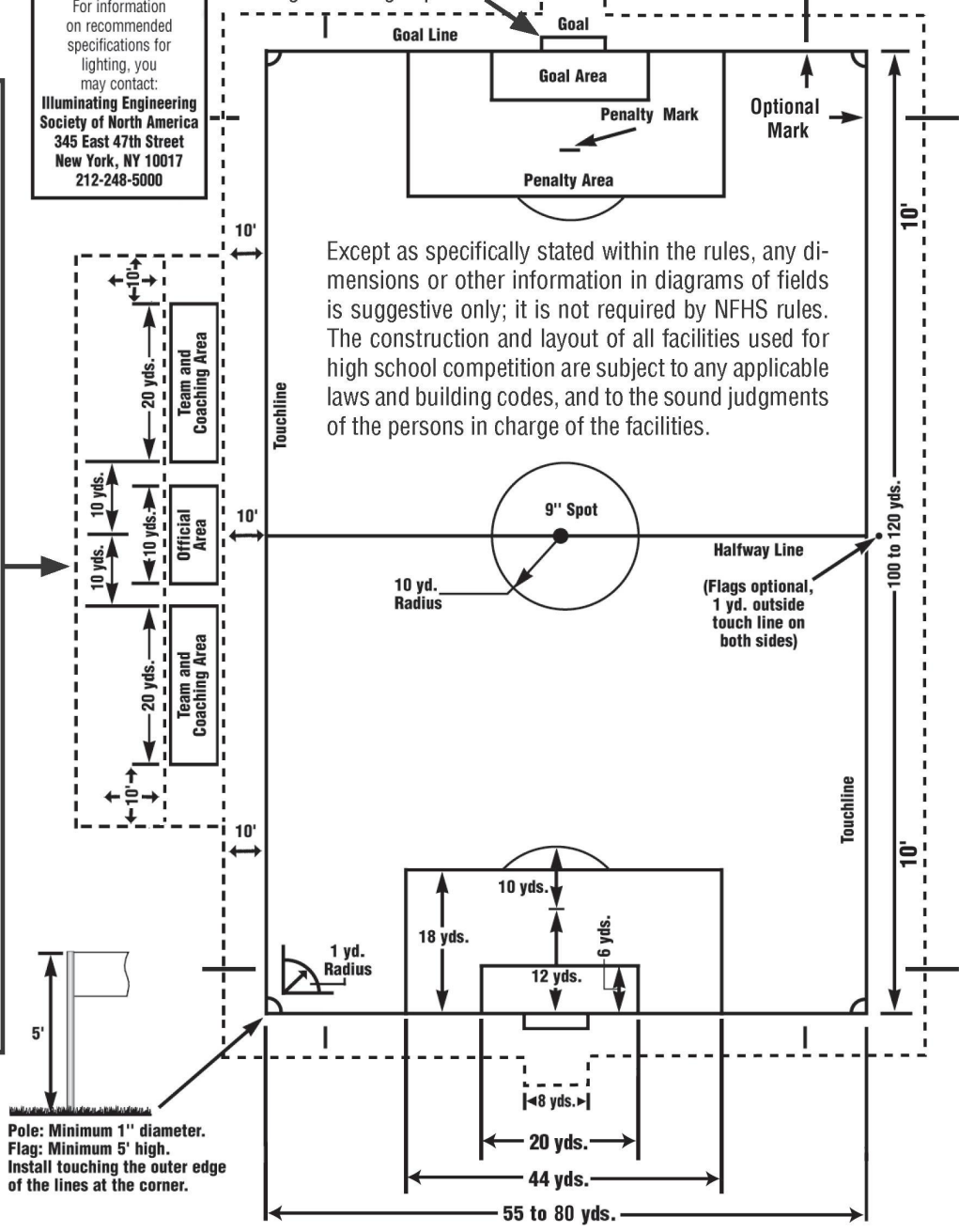
***Measurements** are taken from outside to outside of the line.

Dotted line is minimum boundary for spectators, fencing or any objects.

If used on a football field, portable goals should be anchored at least 2 yards in front of the base of the existing football goalposts.

HASH MARK
 (1 yard in length, 6 inches beyond goal line and touch line, and 11 yards from corner located at each corner of field)



NOTE: An engineered natural turf soccer field should have a minimum of one-and-one-half percent (1.5%) slope for fields which are surface drained. For natural turf fields with a sub-surface drain system the slope should be no less than one (1.0%) percent. For synthetic turf fields with a sub-surface drain system the slope should be no less than one half of one (0.5%) percent. Slope is measured from center to side.
