## 4A/3A/2A/1A Tennis State Championship Schedule

1. **COACHES MEETING:** There is a coach’s meeting Friday morning at 7:30am. The meeting will take place at the outdoor courts unless there is inclement weather. The meeting will be moved to the indoor courts if the weather is questionable. All schools are encouraged to have a coach in attendance.
2. **INCLEMENT WEATHER:** If it is raining, players may proceed directly to inclement weather site. In case of questionable weather, please call the appropriate championship director at the cell number listed above for site confirmation. Match locations will be confirmed at the headquarter site. All matches will be conducted at the appropriate site through the semifinals on Friday. All matches Saturday will be played at OSU Tennis Complex.
3. **INCLEMENT WEATHER PROCEDURES:**
  - A. **Players**
    - 1) Any round started outdoors with full scoring shall be completed indoors with full scoring.
    - 2) Play 2 of 3 sets with “AD” (7-point tiebreaker at 6-All) – rest periods permitted. Play quarterfinals with “AD” and rest.
    - 3) Change ends of the court after odd number of games in a set – same as outdoors (no rest after game one).
    - 4) No spectators are allowed courtside on indoor courts.
    - 5) Follow regular format – use scorecards, if available, call out score before each point.
    - 6) Consolation matches will be Pro-sets (first to 8 games, must win by two with a 7-point tiebreaker at 8 all). “AD” scoring method is used.
  - B. **Coaches**
    - 1) Send out starter – 5 minutes warm up maximum.
    - 2) Three new balls per match.
    - 3) Coaching – see below.
    - 4) Rest Periods – see below.
4. **FORMAT:** Individual competition with 16 players in each bracket, four singles and four doubles teams from each of the four special districts. Team points will be tracked and a team champion declared based upon overall team points. Singles sticks will be used.
