The state shall be divided into eight districts:

District 1 shall be called the Eastern Oregon District and will include the following schools: The Dalles, Hermiston, McLoughlin High, Pendleton, La Grande, Baker, Ontario, Vale and Nyssa.

District 2 shall be called the South Central District and will include the following schools: Burns, Lakeview, Bend, Prineville, Redmond, Klamath Falls, Ashland and Medford.

District 3 shall be called the South West District and will include the following schools: Myrtle Point, Marshfield, North Bend, Roseburg, Grants Pass, Coquille and Reedsport.

District 4 shall be called the West Central District and will include the following schools: Corvallis, Albany, Lebanon, Sweet Home, Cottage Grove, Springfield, University High, Eugene, Junction City, Toledo, Salem, Newport, Elmira, St. Mary's of Eugene and Jefferson.

District 5 shall be called the North Central District and will include the following schools: Hood River, Milwaukie, Gresham, Oregon City, Sandy, Estacada, Canby, Molalla, Silverton, Woodburn, Mt. Angel, Stayton, Dallas and Sacred Heart of Salem.

District 6 shall be called the Western District and will include the following schools: Tillamook, Forest Grove, Hillsboro, Beaverton, Tigard, West Linn, Newberg, McMinnville and Taft.

District 7 shall be called the North West District and will include the following schools: Astoria, Seaside, Vernonia, Rainier, St. Helens, Scappoose, Columbia Prep., Parkrose, Central Catholic, Hill Military Academy and Concordia Academy.

District 8 shall be called the Portland District and will include the Portland Public High Schools: Grant, Washington, Jefferson, Benson, Commerce, Roosevelt, Lincoln and Franklin.
