## DISTRICT COMMITTEE DUTIES

Each district is represented by a committee of three (3) high school principals appointed annually by the Board of Control. Representation for each district in each classification is listed by school (see pages 6 and 7) rather than by name of individual serving on the committee. The principal of the first school listed shall serve as the committee chairman.

All schools should be given equal consideration in the formulation of district plans. These plans should include a method for the selection of representatives in case of ties, and a copy of each should be sent to the OSAA office for approval before notifying schools involved.

**NOTE:** Any school participating in an athletic program that necessitates being placed in a special district listed on pages 5 and 6 should make sure it is included in one of these special districts. Any school not included in a special district and wishing to be included must notify the OSAA office not later than the date listed in the athletic plan for that sport. Athletic plans are published in various issues of THE OSAA INTERSCHOLASTIC.
