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ACTIVITY INFORMATION

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PRACTICE MODEL

- Single Practice Session Day
 - No longer than three hours, including warm-up and cool down
 - Maximum of one hour of weight training either before or after practice
- Multiple Practice Session Day
 - No more than five hours of total practice, including warm-up and cool down.
 - No single practice session shall be longer than three hours, including warm-up and cool down.
 - At least three hours of recovery time between practice sessions
 - During recovery time, students may not engage in other physical activities (e.g., weight training, etc.).



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PRACTICE MODEL CONT.

- Multiple Practice Sessions – Teaching Sessions
 - One practice session of the first two multiple practice days shall be a teaching session only. Conditioning drills (gassers, timed runs, or sprints) shall not be conducted.
 - The intensity, duration, and pace of all practice components shall be modified from a normal practice session.
 - Includes Cheer/Dance choreography sessions
 - The focus should be directed at developing skills fundamental to the sport at a significantly reduced pace.
 - Practice components in all activities intended to develop skills while conditioning the athlete at the same time are not allowed.

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PRACTICE LIMITATION RULE (6A, 5A, 4A)

- Closed Period: August 19 – September 29
 - Optional conditioning is the only activity allowed between out-of-season coaches and students from their high school (including freshmen)
 - No sport-specific activities permitted
 - No coach involved Open Facilities allowed
- Open Period: September 30 – November 17
 - Limited to a maximum of six hours each week per program, not per student (including Open Facilities)
 - Allows optional, fundamental skill development with an unlimited number of student-athletes. No 8th graders or students from other schools may participate
 - No competition or tryouts permitted



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PRACTICE LIMITATION RULE (3A, 2A, 1A)

- No Open or Closed Period
 - Optional Activities Allowed:
 - General conditioning and strength training
 - Open Facilities with no direct instruction
- Rule of Two: two students, per program, per day
 - Receive specialized athletic instruction
 - Applies to all coaches, paid or volunteer
 - May include optional competition
- Baseball/Softball Pitching Exception
 - Two weeks prior to the start of the season



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VOLLEYBALL

- Line judges will switch sides of the court between sets when, by state association adoption, teams remain on the same benches throughout the match.
- **Rationale:** Aligns with the original intent of the rule allowing line judges to alternate between each set to promote fair officiating.
- 2025-26 Season New Ball NOVA Game Ball (launch July '25)

- :35 Shot Clock Optional for sub-varsity
- 2A Basketball Championships Chamber of commerce will take care of your reservations



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SOFTBALL

- One-way communication now allowed between coach and catcher



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FOOTBALL

- Uniform change effective 2024
 - Numbers must contrast with body




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FOOTBALL

- 2024 Illegal Equipment Game protocols
 - First player is a warning, and the player is sent off
 - Each additional violation, the player is sent off and the team is assessed a 5-yard delay of game penalty.

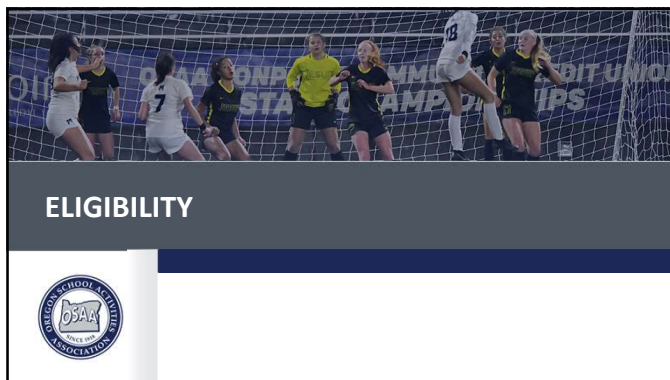

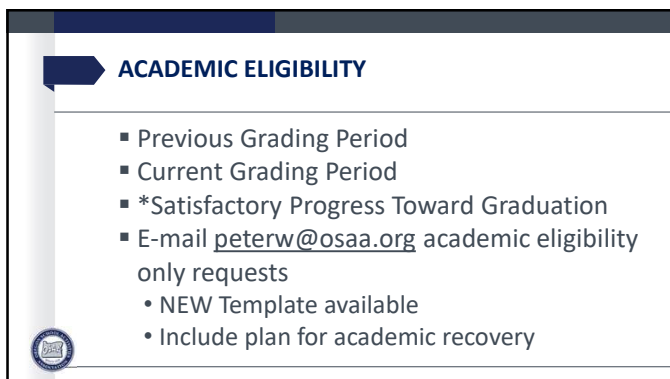

- Student Information** - including name, date of birth, parent/guardian, address, etc.
- Waiver Type** - type of eligibility waiver (see OSAA Handbook, Rule 1)
- Enrollment Records** - student's academic history by semester/semester
- Additional Correspondence** - some eligibility waivers require additional information or correspondence that will need to be uploaded as a separate file and attached to the request (letters, transcripts, etc.)
- Affirmation Signatures** - in order for your request to be submitted, you must read and agree to an affirmation statement (school administrator and student's parent/guardian or host family).

OSAA Eligibility Notice for Waivers Prior to August 15, 2024

Hardship requests involving future eligibility will not be considered by the Executive Director, Executive Board, or Student Athletic Committee. The student must actually be in an ineligible status before any hardship request will be considered except for age and/or Fifth Year waivers.

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Canopy – Pixellot Management Tool


Canopy is a new fleetwide management tool we are using to monitor Pixellot units. It allows us to be more proactive, rather than reactive.



Internet Status

Canopy has allowed us to identify Pixellots with internet issues. Some can be resolved via remote, and others we'll need to partner with the schools for resolution. **Canopy will continue to monitor every unit on a daily basis to keep the fleet healthy.**



Power Status

Is the unit on? If the unit is shut off, has it come back on?

Reboots were a big issue last year. Multiple processes that were creating the reboots unnecessarily have been repaired.



Camera Status & Accuracy

Is the camera online & paired to the VPU.

We are now able to be more proactive and identify Pixellots that have camera issues ahead of time.

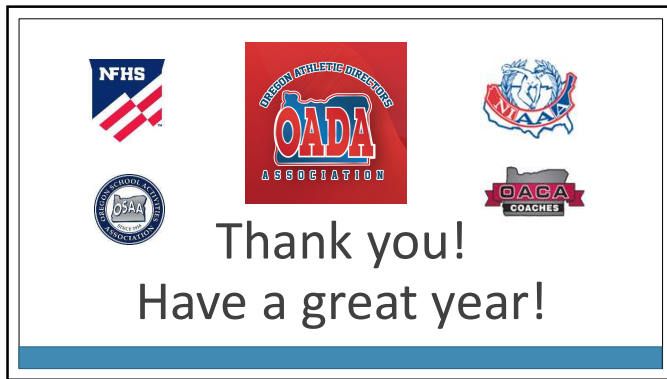

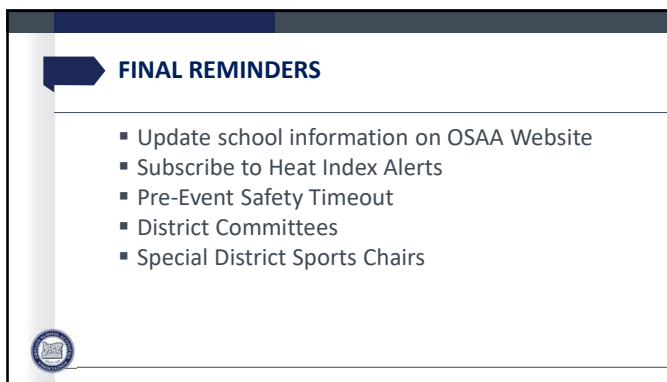
