## OSAA Budget Committee – April 30, 2025

### STANDING PRIORITIES

- Recommend that the OSAA Staff remain diligent when reviewing venues and formats for State Championship activities with a priority on fiscal responsibility while endeavoring to continue providing high quality, memorable state championship experiences for students and communities.
- Recommend that the OSAA continue to commit assets, including specific funding for resources and training, towards equity, inclusion, and diversity initiatives set forth by the OSAA Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion Committee.
- Recommend maintaining the Association's contingency fund between 6% and 8% annually, ideally closer to 8%.
- Recommend that the OSAA continue to invest in its communication tools for the membership and the public. This includes, but is not limited to, website development, social media, promotion of Association activities and sports, collaboration with OACA/OADA for All-League/All-State teams, etc.
- Recommend that the Association annually assess staffing levels to continue meeting the needs of the entire membership. The Association's ongoing efforts to provide more services to member schools and their students, particularly in the area of emerging activities, may necessitate additional personnel.

### 2025-26 TARGETED PRIORITIES

1. Recommend increasing the dues for Associate Member schools by 10% each year for the next two years (20% total increase). Prior to 2024-25, Associate Member Dues had not increased since 2014-15.
2. Recommend a comprehensive review of the new Playoff Reimbursement Formula in place for the past two years. Consider allocating additional funds to the OSAA Reimbursement Formula (currently at \$850,000/year) if the budget allows.
3. Recommend a comprehensive review of ticket prices and all aspects associated with ticket revenue and expenses prior to the 2026-27 budgeting process (i.e., adult/student pricing, early rounds vs. final sites, HomeTown Ticketing fees, OACA/OAOA Gold Cards, venue ticketing fees, etc.).
4. Recommend continued consideration of emerging activities that will meet the changing needs of today's students. Consideration to be given to how any emerging activity can be accessed by the entire membership and the financial considerations related to such new programming opportunities for both member schools and the Association.

### **Charge to the Classification and Districting Committee for the 2026-2030 Time Block**

#### **9.2. Classification and Districting Committee.**

**9.2.1. Charge.** The Committee shall make recommendations to the Executive Board regarding classifications and districts for the upcoming four-year time block. The duties and responsibilities of the Committee shall be:

- (a) To hold public hearings and provide correspondence to interested parties regarding classifications and districts for the upcoming four-year time block.
- (b) To receive testimony from any school or other interested party, including information on the numbers of students currently enrolled in grades 8, 7 and 6.
- (c) To make recommendations to the Executive Board regarding classifications and districts and enrollment limits for the upcoming four-year time block.
- (d) To consider the following criteria (in no particular order), among any others they deem relevant, for recommending placement of schools in regular districts:
  - (1) Regular district history;
  - (2) Competitive balance;
  - (3) Creation of similar sized leagues;
  - (4) Minimizing loss of student instructional time;
  - (5) Minimizing the expenditure of school district and student and parent participant funds;
  - (6) Moving as few schools as possible;
  - (7) Placement of schools within the same school district and classification in the same league;
  - (8) Safety of student participants and school personnel with respect to travel;
  - (9) Scheduling problems;
  - (10) School enrollment data as calculated under Article 6.3.;
  - (11) School preference.
- (e) All schools within a single school district that are in the same size classification (including those smaller schools that have elected to play up with schools in a larger classification) shall be assigned to the same district unless the school board of the affected school district agrees to a different assignment prior to October 1 preceding the quadrennial December Classification and Districting meeting.

**9.2.2. Composition.** Committee membership shall mirror the Executive Board. Each classification and affiliated organization represented on the Executive Board shall be represented by an appointment to the Committee.

The Vice President of the Executive Board shall serve as ex-officio, non-voting member of the Committee.

**9.2.3. Term.** Members of the Committee shall serve through one review cycle and may be reappointed to subsequent committees at the discretion of the Executive Board. The Committee recommendations shall be made to the Executive Board within the school year prior to the changes being implemented.

**9.2.4. Meetings.** The Committee shall adopt a schedule of meetings based upon the issues under consideration. The schedule shall include an appropriate number of meetings in which to conduct the business of the Committee and may include travel to several venues.

**ADDITIONAL CHARGE:** The OSAA Executive Board further requests that the Classification and Districting Committee for 2026-30 investigate and report regarding the feasibility and advisability of:

- A. Alignments that reduce travel, when possible.
- B. Reducing the number of classifications.
- C. Adjusting classification cutoff points.

## OACA Volleyball Proposal - 2025

### Request for change to individual participation limits language

#### Current Language (OSAA):

##### 13. VOLLEYBALL

B. Individual. A student shall not compete on more than 18 playing dates / 36 matches, exclusive of varsity district playoffs and state championships. **Additionally, a student shall not compete in more than one set in addition to one match per day. Once a player participates in the second set of a match that constitutes their match for that day.** If a student exceeds the limit, the match in which the limit is exceeded shall be forfeited.

#### Proposed Change: (For 1A, 2A, 3A, and 4A)

**New language to replace what is highlighted above:** Additionally, a student shall not compete in more than 6 sets per day. Once a player participates in more than 6 sets that constitutes their limit for that day.

\*5 sets was the original proposal and what our survey was based on. **After further discussion at the OACA meeting it was pointed out that 6 sets make more sense than 5 so that varsity players can help assure that JV teams are able to play at least 2 out of 3 sets.**

- The OACA executive board proposed a modification to the proposal language: Change from a limit of 5 sets to 6 sets.
- This recommendation was unanimously supported by the board.

#### Rationale for the Proposed Change:

1. The change would provide an increase in opportunities for more playing time for sub-varsity athletes at our lower classification level (1A - 4A).
  - a. For schools who are struggling with participation numbers, it gives coaches more opportunities to utilize swing players between sub-varsity and varsity contests.
    - i. The committee felt this change could benefit 1A - 4A programs, but was not necessarily needed at 5A - 6A. This could be discussed further to determine if this change should be recommended for all classifications.
  - b. For example, at the 1A level for the past several years many schools have not been able to play a JV and Varsity match on the same day due to low total program numbers. The change would help ensure that a sub-varsity match (2 of 3) could be played on the same day as a varsity match, giving young athletes an opportunity for game play, which is critical for the development.
2. A defined number of sets makes the management of playing time easier for coaches and athletes to prepare for and keep track of. This clarity would hopefully help avoid some of the penalties that were seen this fall for violation of the current rule.
3. It aligns with other team sport's participation limitation formats, such as basketball and football. This helps athletes and parents better understand the rules and regulations.
4. There are no medical issues to be concerned about with this rule change. Volleyball athletes are allowed to play much more on tournament days.
5. This rule change should help to ensure that sub-varsity contests are played in one of the two OSAA approved formats for sub-varsity matches (2 out of 3 or 3 out of 5).
6. There is no known financial impact to the OSAA.
  - a. The only known financial impact to member schools could be an increase in official costs due to the possibility of additional sub-varsity matches being scheduled.



**Survey Data:**

- Based on a survey of athletic directors and coaches which was conducted in the winter of 2024, 59.3% of 177 survey participants supported the proposed change to 5. There was support from both coaches and athletic directors at all levels. Some of the comments supported 6 sets but we don't have the survey results for that as a question.

**Survey Question - Response Choices:**

- The current policy: A student shall not compete in more than one set in addition to one match per day. (36.7%)
- Modification to the policy: A student shall not compete in more than five total sets. (59.3%)

**Data Breakdown:** (including the individual comments for a modification) 61% in support of modification of the current language.

- 68 of 105 coaches agreed that there should be a modification to the policy
- 40 of 72 athletic directors agreed there should be a modification to the policy

**Additional Comments:**

- Comments from Coaches:
  - I think it should six or seven sets in any form
  - No more than six total sets. If that is not possible, then no more than five.
  - A student shall not compete in more than TWO sets in addition to the one match per day.
- Comments from athletic directors:
  - I'm fine with two full matches per day. Most, if not all, could handle two games easily.
  - The current rule is 16 sets, and volleyball is non contact. Allow athletes to compete in 16 sets no matter level.
  - A student shall not compete in no more than 6 total sets.
  - Need more information

### 13. VOLLEYBALL

(Revised May 2025)

- A. **Team.** A school team shall not compete on more than 18 playing dates / 36 matches, at each level of competition, exclusive of the varsity district playoffs and state championships.
- B. **Individual.** A student shall not compete on more than 18 playing dates / 36 matches, exclusive of varsity district playoffs and state championships. ~~Additionally, a student shall not compete in more than one set in addition to one match per day. Once a player participates in the second set of a match that constitutes their match for that day.~~ **Additionally, a student shall not compete in more than six total sets per day at different levels.** If a student exceeds the limit, the match in which the limit is exceeded shall be forfeited. A student may participate in more than one jamboree in a day but is limited to not more than four sets total.  
  
**EXCEPTION:** The individual limit of ~~one set in addition to one match per day~~ **six total sets per day at different levels** does not apply to double duals or tournament play. In tournament play, a student may participate in only one level of competition during that day. Double duals involve two or three ~~teams~~ **schools** competing on one day. In double dual play, a student may participate in ~~multiple levels of play~~ and may play in a maximum of **ten** sets **at the same level** during that day.
- C. **Jamboree.** A school may participate in only one jamboree at each level of competition. A jamboree shall include at least three teams and shall not be counted as a contest. Jamborees may be held only on the first playing date and for 30 days thereafter. A jamboree is limited to not more than four sets per team and limited to not more than one set appearance against any school (three or more teams). Sets played in jamborees shall use rally scoring to 25 points. A student may participate in more than one jamboree in a day but is limited to not more than four sets total.
