Westview High School seeks a highly qualified individual to serve as a Varsity Softball Coach. A successful candidate will possess the following qualities:

- Demonstrated ability to be a positive leader in a basketball program, developing and instructing young athletes academically, physically and emotionally.
- Ability to communicate effectively to a variety of stakeholders through various methods, including athletes, parents, families/staff, AD's office and public relations.
- Experience with computer technology a plus, including Microsoft Office, G-Suite and sportspecific software: Game Changer
- Technical knowledge of softball strategy, staff management, skill development, and coaching techniques
- Previous experience managing a budget and organizing fundraisers to ensure the program and athletes have all the required items to be successful

The Coach will be responsible for supporting all aspects of the high school program including but not limited to:

- Formation of teams followed by implementation of program standards & culture.
- Organizing Varsity practices and communicating clear expectations and standards to players and other coaches.
- Off-season workouts in fall, winter, and summer in accordance with OSAA 6A regulations, including strength & conditioning as well as on-field sport specific training
- Tracking the academic progress of student athletes and facilitating necessary support to ensure their academic eligibility and long-term success
- Advertising, organizing and running off-season camps, practices, trainings and events
- Working with our youth programs to develop strong participation numbers and promote athletics

The Coach reports directly to the High School Principal and Athletic Director. Salary to be determined by experience and the BSD negotiated contract. Some responsibilities outside the winter season may provide additional compensation above the winter coaching stipend.

Qualified applicants would have 3+ years of coaching experience, with previous head coaching experience preferred. Applicants should have a willingness to become a member of our community and to improve through professional development.

All new hired coaches will need to complete the following prior to employment:

- 1. NFHS Certification.
- 2. First Aid Card.
- 5. Completion -OSAA Steroid Program.
- 6. Completion- OSAA Heat Acclimatization/Heat Illness Prevention.
- 3. District Fingerprinting/Criminal Check.
- 7. Completion of All District Requirements, OSAA paperwork and employment forms.
- 4. Completion of OSAA Concussion
